State Superintendent of Schools

Superintendent Cox devoted her talk to mathematics, saying that field of study is as important as literacy.

She noted that the United States is 24th out of 30 countries in the math proficiency of its students, and that Georgia's math SAT scores have been among the lowest of the states.

But, she said, implementation of the "Georgia Performance Standards Mathematics Curriculum" is reversing that trend, and the improvement is showing up in Glynn as well as other counties.

The program features in-depth study and an "integrated" approach in each field of mathematics.

As State Superintendent of Schools and Chief Executive Officer of the State Board of Education, Kathy Cox has led Georgia's 181 public school districts since her election in November of 2002. She spent 15 years as a classroom teacher and served two terms in the Georgia legislature.

As the mother of two school-age sons, Superintendent Cox says she seeks policies and programs that support teachers, empower parents, and inspire students.

She is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Emory University.

Anita Crispin

A moment of silence was held for **Anita Crispin**, a resident of Sea Island and Berwick, PA, who died July 3 at her summer home in Blue Hill, Maine.

She was a neo-impressionist painter whose work has been featured in several galleries across the East Coast.

Born in Teaneck, NJ, in 1940, she attended Marymount College in Virginia, the Art Students League of New York, the School of Visual Arts in Manhattan, and the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts in Philadelphia.

In addition to the SSI Rotary Club, she had been active in many community and charitable organizations.
