Reports and Goals by the Incoming President, Directors & Committee Members

President Jim Bruce told his fellow Rotarians that increasing membership will be a major goal for 2007-2008.

(John also asked for more feedback on the monthly socials – at which attendance has been up and down.)
- Club Relations/Public Relations Director Stan Kyker said his committee needs a volunteer to monitor and report on the wellness of members.
