Today's Program - May 10, 2011

Bill Curry, Head Football Coach, Georgia State University.

A person whose name is synonymous with class and integrity in the coaching profession. Bill Curry is the architect and builder of the Georgia State University football program as the program's first head coach. Curry spent more than two years developing, directing and promoting the football program in preparation for State's inaugural season. The fledging squad posted a winning record of 6-5 and exceeded all expectations. Coach Curry called his current post at Georgia State the highlight of his storied career.

Program - May 3, 2011 The Bruce-Tharp Rotary Scholarships

In 1961 the club established a fund for lending money to students to attend college, to be repaid after graduation at no interest, under the leadership of Ed Bruce. The Scholarship Fund was converted to a full scholarship program in 1991. In 1997, Gil Tharp left a sizeable amount of money to the fund in his will. The scholarships are awarded from the earnings from the fund along with the donations from club members. Students attending CCGA receive \$1000 per year for 4 years while the other winners receive \$2000 per year for the college of their choice. The committee is headed by Mike Muldowney. This year Scott Cown, Dwight Plyler and Steve Hires evaluated all 30 applications and choose 15 students for interviews.
