In Early August – Students began arriving in Georgia – Greeted by Host Families and Rotarians in all three Georgia District. As soon as they had settled in to their new surroundings - Bainbridge GA was the site of the **2017-2018 GRSP Conclave** – the first Official event bringing together all participating Students, again, in all THREE Georgia Districts for two days of getting acquainted, team building and bonding between host families and Sponsoring Clubs.
